1 *SOUTH COUNTY TRAFFIC MODEL REPORT*

Dale will have a Power Point presentation and pass-by rate comparison for the August SCAC meeting. Copies of the report will be available for council review during the week of August 7th. Report will go to the Board of Supervisors as a consent public hearing agenda item in the middle of September.

2 *STATUS OF TEFFT-MARY-HILL-FRONTAGE PROJECTS (TMHF?)*

Developer agreement is ready for Ted Moore's signature. Plans have been submitted for the Mary Street improvements. Pre bid meeting has been held by Vons and Wallace staff for the raised median in front of Von's. The work will most likely be done at night. Terry Flatley hopes to start construction of his project early next year.

3 *PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AND WHAT IT MEANS TO THE SOUTH COUNTY*

Public Works contracted with a paving consultant to develop a pavement management plan. The consultant prepared a condition report and a five-year workplan for all of the paved roads in the County. 25% of the roads will be re-assessed each year. Due to the nature of maintenance dollars the County study areas do not correspond the traffic mitigation fee areas. This work is funded by County road funds (tax funding). The South County Road Improvement fees do not pay for maintenance costs. The 2005/06 workplan includes an overlay on Pomeroy and chip sealing on 31 Nipomo area roads.

4 Other issues

Dales was asked to look at a sinkhole on Amber and root damage to the pavement on Lema. In an email cc Dale asked the road maintenance supervisor to correct the two problems.
