Public Comment

Fencing and Landscaping at Tefft and Pomeroy is unattractive.

Park traffic is using Primrose and Gardenia increasing traffic volumes on those streets. There are some perceived speeding problems also.

Old Business

1) Reconsideration for limit lines at stop sign Black Lake Canyon Drive and Golf Course Lane.
Ryan Chapman will reconsider the request.

2) Results of drop inlet request on the east side of Tefft, between Hazel and Eucalyptus.
Ryan Chapman will remind Road Maintenance to look at the situation.

3) Has there been any progress on the Hazel pinch point correction?
Ryan Chapman will add this to the budget submittal.

4) Has the vegetation along Tefft at the overpass vehicles using the southbound offramp been removed?
Not yet. Ryan will query CalTrans about removal.

5) Please fill us in on the SR2S project.
Construction should be starting Public Works is determining if there will be any impacts on the Senior Center parking. Project should be complete in the next three or four months.

6) Light timing at Tefft and Mary.
Ryan will contact CalTrans as the signal is linked in with the freeway signals

New Business

1) 2010 South County Circulation Study update.
Fees are not yet calculated. Bid results from Willow, Phase 2 and Prop. 1b timing will affect the fees. There will be more information next month. Dale/Los Berros and South Orchard projects will be put off. Ryan is updating the various Willow Road funding to reflect the new phasing. Jim Tefft has concerns about the Thompson/Chestnut improvements location on the priority list. This would be feasible only with the advent of other funding. Ryan plans to remove the completed items from the list.

2) Explanation of income, expenditures and balances for RIF Area 2.

3) Tell us about the Hutton Road improvements and the construction schedule.

Project is underway. Project includes 4-foot shoulder widening and center turn lane from Nipomo Creek Bridge to Cuyama Lane. At the last drive-by drainage features were being installed and the fence bordering the freeway was being moved. Project will be completed by March or April.

Member Comments

There are some concerns about Dawn Road and Camino Caballo being used as arterials to and from Woodlands. Although these roads are accepted for maintenance by Public Works none has been done. Legal status of these two roads needs to be determined. Public Works, with committee approval will install stop signs at Theodora and Chata.
