Old Business

1) Status of Willow Road, Phase II project.
Still on schedule

2) Have traffic light changes at Tefft and Mary been made?
Ryan Chapman will continue discussions with CalTrans.

3) Paving degradation on Riverside Road below December blowout area.
Public Works people will be looking at this.

4) Legality of signing in Woodlands, on Sequoia and on Verano.
Signing was probably put in at the request of a Traffic Engineer but have no legal bearing until the County accepts them.

5) Roundabouts at Cienega Street and Halcyon and SR 1 and Halcyon.
Ryan Chapman passed out a plan sheet and a project study. After review, we will consider it next month. The project will probably be scheduled for 2020 construction.

6) Who is responsible for walkway maintenance on the East side of Division between Sequoia and Tyrus Court.
Ryan Chapman will look into the CC&Rs and get back to us.

7) Sight distance problems at Mary and Hill and Osage and Tejas.
Ryan will encourage the maintenance crews to do some trimming.

New Business

1) Black Lake Village road maintenance program.
Public Works will do a slurry seal in two years. Need to determine location of root encroachment.

2) Non-operational street lights at Willow and Pomeroy.
Ryan Chapman will check with Dale Ramey

3) Traffic counts on Tejas.
Speed survey will support 35 mph. Stop signs are not warranted.

4) Request to have Nipomo population sign updated on 101.
Ryan will check with CalTrans

5) 2011 Circulation Study Update.
T&CC will review the submittals and discuss this at the next meeting. We will plan of bringing this to the October 24 SCAC meeting
