Special Topic

1) Traffic Increases Caused by Expanded Nursery Operations on Viva Way.

Janice Porter, Mike Berry and Nancy Shipley made a detailed presentation of the neighborhood problems.

Ryan Chapman indicated people are running stop signs on Camino Caballo. He is looking for a way to upgrade the stop signs. He is considering seven ton weight limit signs on Waypoint and Olympic. Traffic counts have been done and Public Works is waiting for data analysis to determine the amount of increased traffic.

Dave Pruitt of the Greenhouse Growers Association indicated that one of his jobs is to try to deal with problems between growers and the public. When asked if he thought that this was a warehousing operation he indicated that it was "somewhat of a warehousing situation".

Supervisor Teixeira indicated that Code Enforcement is trying to determine how much of the operation is agricultural and how much is distribution.

He also indicated that we should let the code enforcement process run its course.
