Public Comment: A trailer has been parked at 101 and Los Berros for months. Excessive littering at the Willow Interchange. Someone needs to form an adopt-a-road group. Contaminated soil haul route change.

Old Business

- a. Most of the foliage at corner of Cascada and Whimbrel Court has been removed.
- b. Right turn and left turn lane extensions along Willow from Misty Glen to Via Concha is being considered by District 4 Supervisor Caren Ray. Has Public Works had a chance to evaluate this proposal.

New Business

a. Site distance problem caused by foliage in right-of-way at northeast corner of Hill and Mary.
Public Works will consider this.

b. Higher foliage west of Olympic covers up the stop sign for eastbound traffic on Olympic at Camino Caballo.
Public Works will consider this.

There is a request for a 55 mph sign for eastbound traffic on Willow to be installed east of SR-1.
Public Works will install a sign.

- c. Request for rehab of Halcyon Road between SR-1 and Appaloosa Way – Dan Woodson
 - a. What is the PMI of the segment?

 - b. Where does this request stand with respect to Public Works priorities for repairs?
Public Works indicates that they will do an overlay during FY 15/16. Funding will be from the North Mesa Assessment District

d. Update on South county Traffic Model.
RFQ will go to the BOS on October 7.

e. Update on Swap Meet Mary/Juniper changes.
A dedicated left turn lane and a dedicated right turn/straight ahead lane will be marked on Hill. Other traffic markings will be installed on the remainder of Mary between Tefft and Juniper.
