a) Status of Traffic Study. Was the discretionary project list added to the Traffic for the BoS meeting. Discretionary project list is still included with the master list.

b) Improve sight distance on the northeast corner of Mary and Hill by removing invasive vegetation. Vegetation has been removed

New Business

a) Traffic generated by the Swap Meet.  
Lane backups on the freeway are a CalTrans issue. Future Tefft Street Ramp and Bridge improvements should reduce the problem

b) Parking at the Willows Restaurant is overflowing into the street. Is there some way of marking the RoW to better control the parking. Public Works will investigate. Art Herbon has sent pictures of the problem to Public Works

c) Complaints about blocking bike lane along South Frontage Road near Grande. Public Works is aware of the problem and will consider enforcement opportunities.

d) County Bicycle Plan update

e) Sporadic stripping along Usage.  
A question about insufficient road width and a lack of recorded accidents left those segments unstripped.
