- DRC2016-00068 Howard Pepper Trailer Hitch RV Project Proposed Conditional Use Permit for a Recreational Vehicle dealership and outdoor storage at corner of North Frontage and Sandydale Drive in Nipomo. Tabled for one month at the June SCAC meeting. Status? <u>Link To DRC2016-00068</u>
- 2. 2018/2019 Proposed SCAC Budget (Spelbring)
- 3. DRC2017-00118 SLO CULTIVATION PROJECT DESCRIPTION: * (Revised). Proposed Conditional Use Permit for Cannabis activity to include cultivation, nursery, and retail delivery service: located at 1808 and 1810 Willow Road as well 520 Albert Way, Arroyo Grande <u>Link to DRC2017-00118</u>
 - 3.1. SCAC recommended denial of this project at the March, 2018 meeting, and had a split-vote on a modified version (no outdoor grow). The project has been modified, and Land Use Committee requested that SCAC review the project again. Changes:
 - 3.1.1.Outdoor growth is increased from one to two acres.
 - 3.1.2. Byer's Odor System to be placed around entire outdoor growth (non in previous application)
 - 3.1.3. No manufacturing activity as previously requested.
 - 3.1.4. No commercial kitchen as previously requested.

NEW BUSINESS

- DRC2018-00040 Dayspring Proposed Minor Use Permit for one acre outdoor cannabis cultivation site and 22,000 sq. ft of indoor (greenhouse) cannabis cultivation to be located on Cougar Ridge Way and Suey Creek Road in Santa Maria, CA <u>Link To DRC2018-00040</u>
 - 1.1. Presentation at Land Use Meeting did not match the written application (see Link). The cannabis application dated 4/10/18 requests 22,000 sf of indoor greenhouse, and 1 acre of outdoor growth. The applicant told Land Use that outdoor growth, up to one-acre, will utilize hoops to cover crops, instead of indoor greenhouse.
 - 1.2. Owner holds three contiguous parcels, one with a water well that will be utilized for this crop.
 - 1.3. Applicant has been growing cannabis at this location for 13 years.
