PROJECT NUMBER & NAME: C-DRC2022-00004 Coastal Development/Minor Use Permit PROJECT DESCRIPTION*: Request by Coastal San Luis Resource Conservation District for Oso Flaco creek sediment reduction and pesticide remediation (within the Oso Flaco Creek Corridor and adjacent private agricultural lands). Removal of sediment contaminated with pesticides from 1.2 miles of Oso Flaco Creek while concurrently implementing upstream sediment controls designed to capture and remove sediment before it enters the Creek. The project scope includes three components: (1) sediment control Best Management Practices (BMP), (2) sediment excavation from the creek channel, and (3) on-site sediment remediation. MND/Initial Study has been prepared (State Clearinghouse No. 2021040611). Project prepared by the Coastal San Luis Resource Conservation District for the State Water Resources Control Board.
