Dear Supervisor Compton:

The SCAC took the following actions at its September 23, 2019 meeting:

AT&T MOBILITY – DCR2018-00038 – A proposed Conditional Use Permit for a 55’ tall antenna support structure disguised as a water tank with a small ground mounted equipment enclosure and generator within a fenced area at 1390 Los Berros Road, Arroyo Grande. The Council had a question regarding the potential generator noise but received information that this issue would be automatically addressed at the Planning Commission Hearing. The Council subsequently entertained a motion to recommend approval and it passed with a unanimous vote.

DOG TRAINING FACILITY – DRC2019-00163 – A proposed Conditional Use Permit to establish a training, boarding and grooming facility for 30 emotional support dogs at 776 Calle Bendita in Arroyo Grande. No new structures are anticipated. Adjacent properties are zoned industrial and the neighbors have been contacted regarding the plans. The Land Use Committee recommended approval. The Council voted unanimously to recommend approval.

ST JOSEPH CATHOLIC CHURCH – DRC2019-00188 – A proposed Conditional Use Permit to construct a 967 sq. ft. conference room and 484 sq. ft. restroom facility at 298 Thompson Ave. Nipomo. The applicant’s agent requested that this item be postponed until SCAC’s October meeting so that he could present it to the community.
