South County Advisory Council Announces 2026 Elections

South County Advisory Council (SCAC) to the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors will hold its annual election March 16, 2026 from 5:00pm to 8:00pm at the Dana Adobe Cultural Center located at 671 S Oakglen, Nipomo. The SCAC's fully elected council advises the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors on South County issues. The SCAC represents the South County (Inland and Coastal) Area that covers the territory from Los Berros Road south to the county line.

The council consists of 2 elected representatives from each of the seven geographical areas in the South County and two special interest representatives. This year, there are 13 positions open for election with varying terms of office. There is one 2-year position open in each of the areas 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7. There are also 1-year positions open in areas 1, 2, 4, 6, and 7. The Public Safety position is open for election for a 2-year period. Voters from each geographical area elect their own representatives, but the Public Safety representative is voted at large. Each seat is open to be filled by the incumbent or new applicants based on the results of the election.

Prospective candidates must submit applications between February 2 and March 2, 2026 to be placed on the Ballot. Applications may also be available at the Dana Adobe Cultural Center and the Nipomo Public Library.

At this meeting, each applicant will be given the opportunity to give a brief three-minute presentation on their background as well as answer questions from the audience.
