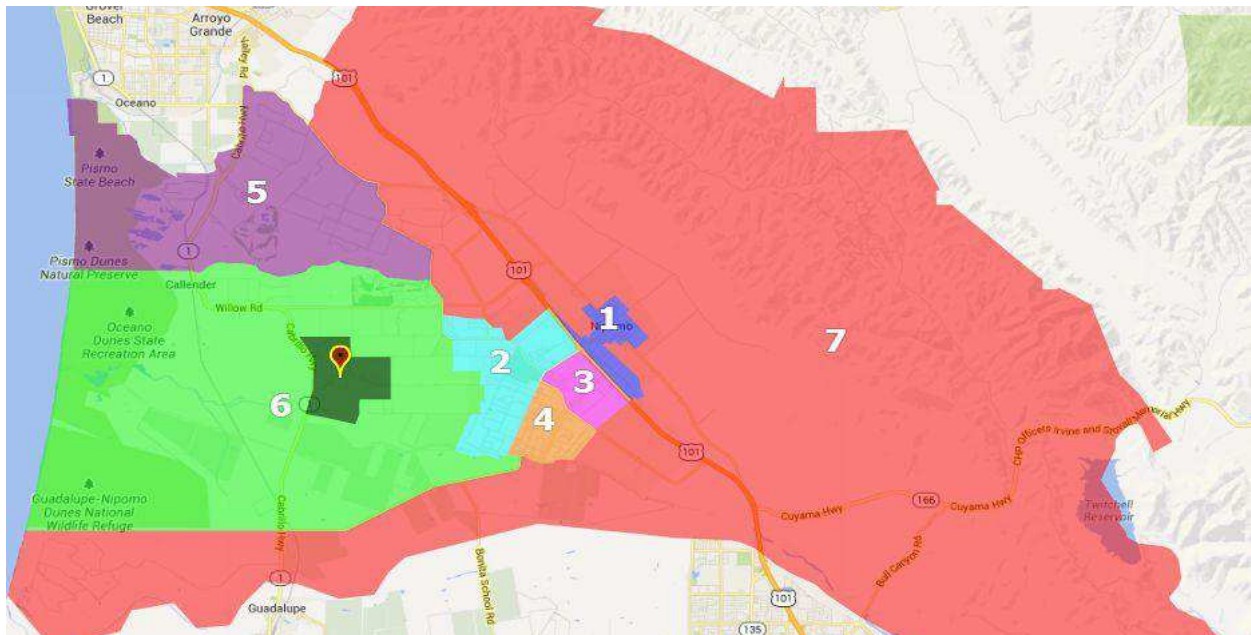

South County Advisory Council Seeking Candidates

The South County Advisory Council (SCAC) is an elected group, sanctioned by the San Luis Obispo Board of Supervisors, to provide a forum for citizen involvement, education and information on issues affecting unincorporated areas of the South County. Monthly meetings are conducted to review pending planning projects. The SCAC sends its recommendations to the Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors.

SCAC currently has several openings that can be filled by appointment, without having to run for election. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and reside in the geographic area they wish to represent. Current vacancies exist in Areas 1, 3, 4, 5, & 7: <https://scac.ca.gov/map/>
