SUB2015 0004 CO15-0055 HURDLE- Proposed parcel map to subdivide one parcel of approximately 0.91 acres into four parcels of 18,949 sf. 6,987 sf. 6,286 sf. and 7,017 sf. Site location is 875 Theodora St. Nipomo. APN:092-573-021

Chris Hurdle, applicant, was present and explained his proposal to seek subdivision of his parcel in that almost all the surrounding large parcels had already been subdivided and developed in the 14 years of his residency.

Istar Holliday told those present that she, El-Jay Hansson and Hans Hansson had visited the property and could confirm the increased density of the area in the recent past.

During the discussion that ensued, a question arose as to the need for paved sidewalks between this project and Orchard Road. Jeanne Taylor said she would raise the subject with the Traffic and Circulation Committee when it meets next.
