The most recent accident, a serious one, was on February 8th. There exists a yellow cautionary curve sign indicating a safe speed of 10 mph. At the intersection there is a turning maneuver of more than 90 degrees. Residents indicated a need for a flashing LED warning sign and have talked to Public Works. Dale Ramey
