1 *Press release for the road priority list.*

Dave presented a proposed press release. Committee decided to include *Nipomo and the rest of South County* as a place name. Dave will refine the release and email it to the committee. We will also get this info on the web site.

2 *Willow Road Funding Schemes: How does the Mello-Roos process operate? How will deficits in funding be accomplished.*

Bond sale may not be allowed until developer finishes site infrastructure. Deficits may be funded by a South County property tax increase

3 *Effects of Valdivio initiative on South County road projects (other than those funded by mitigation fees).*

Reference made to SLOCOG analysis. Committee encourages SCAC to take a stance on this issue

4 *Status of RV encroachment on Juniper.*

Owner will need to quite encroaching by next week.
