Public Comment

Old Business

- 1) Status of Willow Road, Phase 2 – Did everything get submitted? Is the acquisition of the Universal Life Church property going to pose a problem?

The plans will be done by the end of the month. The second week in April the plans will be submitted to the CTC for RTIP funding approval. The condemnation hearing has been put back a month.

- 2) Is there an update on the Mallagh speed humps?

The speed study indicated that 54% of the time vehicles were going faster than 24 mph with 400 to 500 cars per day. Individual residents were not signing the speed hump petition. Committee agreed to request 25 mph sign (25 mph criteria is met) and revisit the speed hump in the future.

- 3) There have been two reports of traffic light timing problems at Division and Orchard. Could someone look into this?

Ryan Chapman referred to a gap issue. Ryan has increased the minimum times of crossing and hopes that a making a few adjustments to the timing sequence should fix the problem today. The emergency preemption sequence may have caused a problem and has been shut down.

- 4) Has any progress been made with the blind intersections?

Maintenance crews have been removing some vegetation. Letters have been sent to property owners asking for vegetation removal. More complaints will be accepted.

- 5) Has anyone looked at the pavement failure at Hill and Frontage?

This has been corrected.

New Business

Nipomo Creek Bridge Maintenance.

SLOCOG is amending the Federal Transportation Improvement Plan to include several County bridges for the Bridge Preventative Maintenance Program. The Nipomo Creek Bridge on Tefft is programmed to have a methacrylate deck seal.
