Public Comment

Bonnie Eisner indicated she was able to travel from her home to the meeting without missing a stop light.

Old Business

1) Status of Willow Road, Phase I

Pete Newel, Resident Engineer for the Willow Road Project gave us an update on the project. He indicated that Hettrick should be open in the second week of February

2) Brush clearing at I01 SB offramp and Tefft.

Bonnie Eisner reported that the brush was removed and visibility was restored.

3) Time line for Willow Road, Phase II.

Ryan Chapman will get the committee a schedule.

4) Bike lanes on Division and South Las Flores.

Based on neighborhood surveys Public Works Staff recommended that bike lanes be implemented on Division Road but not on South Las Flores Road. Bonnie Eisner moved and Jeanne Taylor seconded that the committee support staff recommendations. Subsequent vote was unanimously in favor.

New Business

1) Traffic Study for Clinic expansion.

Ryan Chapman is analyzing the report and will be asking for a walkway on Tejas, dedicated right turn lanes on Tefft to Tejas and from Tejas to Tefft and a transit stop.

2) Vegetation obscuring visibility on W/B Hill Street on NE corner of intersection at Mary Street.

Ryan Chapman will determine the extent of the problem and look for corrective procedures.

3) Speed Survey on Tejas.

A speed survey was conducted January 10 between 10:15 and 11:33 am 85th percentile speed was determined to be 40 MPH. Fifty cars were assessed during the time frame with only one exceeding 45 MPH.

4) Request for equestrian signs on Tejas.

Ryan Chapman will be placing traffic cameras to determine the extent of equestrian usage.

5) There is quite a bit of pavement deterioration in Tefft between Mary and Orchard. Are there any plans for repairs. Arrangements will be made to have Public Works maintenance look at the problem

Member Comments

Haulers for Conoco-Phillips are causing some traffic problems.

Cars are queuing up in the traveled way of Highway 101 at the northbound off ramp.

There is a major breach on the bluff about one mile east of Division on Riverside.

Dawn Road is blocked off at Highway 1.

Left turns are still a problem at Pomeroy and Calle Fresca and Pomeroy and Camino Caballo.

New walkways on Thompson near Dwight's appear inadequate.

Ryan handed out updated Public Works organization charts and current South County project listing.
