Old Business

1) Status of Willow Road, Phase I project.

A paved median is being prepared to allow a detour for northbound traffic while the northbound lane is under construction. Some nesting hawks were found on the site and a buffer zone has been fenced to protect the parents and fledglings.

- 2) Is the schedule for Willow Road, Phase II available?
 Ryan Chapman gave us the most recent schedule in Gantt chart form.
- 3) Update on the Landscaping encroachment on North Dakglen. Landscaping has been cleared.
 - 4) Has the traffic study for the Community Clinic been completed and if so, what are the conclusions. No
- 5) Has performance improved since of traffic light changes were made by CalTrans at 101 and Tefft. There is some improvement but there is too much traffic using that interchange. Hopefully the new Willow Road Interchange will reduce the congestion.
- 6) Have there been any problems with the detour at Calle Fresca and Pomeroy? There were some complaints from Knollwood residents. The detour is now decommissioned.

New Business

1) Is there an accident report available for the first curve at the top of the hill on Division Road between Los Flores and Riverside Road?

- 3) Would a crosswalk crossing Halcyon at SR I about 150 feet east of SR Ibe possible? Ryan Chapman would not recommend approval of the crosswalk.
- 4) Proposed no parking zone on Southland near Honey Grove.

 Ryan Chapman will talk to the affected neighbors and return to the next meeting with a drawing of the no-parking proposal.
