Public Comment

Old Business

- a. Speed bumps on Sequoia Lane/Humboldt Drive between Golden Leaf Lane and Cascade.

County Public Works presented the following, two alternatives for consideration:

- Recommend installation of the speed humps and forward to the BOS via the South County Advisory Committee.
- Recommend Public Works install 2 additional (one in each direction) 25MPH speed limit signs and 25 mile per hour pavement markings on the entrance to the Sequoia/Humboldt curve and collect speed/volume data 2-3 months after installation for comparison to the baseline speeds measured in September 2014. If speed humps are still desired require 60% of the traffic shed for approval.

Following a little more than an hour of public discussion the committee voted unanimously recommend the second alternative. This will be presented to the SCAC during the T&CC report.

- b. Status of request for a No Parking zone on the north side of Tefft near McDonalds.

This had never had any followup from Public Works after the initial request. Michelle Matson will investigate the installation of a sign to eliminate overnight parking.

New Business

- a. There are two stop signs for traffic northbound on Olympic. One is at Pomeroy and has PW property tags on it. The other is about fifty feet south of Pomeroy and has no property tags.

Michelle will determine the ownership of the stop signs.
