Public comments: Sign on Dana School island has been destroyed. Flashing pavement lights at that location may be installed in the next 18 months.

Public Works Updates: OTNA street light bulbs are being replaced. Next week the yield signs on Bennet will be installed. Public Works is considering hiring a consultant to analyze the Tefft Interchange Complex traffic signal situation.

New Business

a) Request for parking restrictions on west side of South Frontage Road at Tefft and north side of Storey near South Frontage Road. As a first step edge markings will be applied to Storey Street to enable sight distance observation. Public Works will consider limited parking on S. Frontage and Tefft.

b) Revisit speed limits and signage along Willow between Pomeroy and Via Concha. Considerable time was spent explaining the actions that have been taken. Public Works indicated that that the westbound sign on Willow at Via Concha, will be relocated further to the east and an advisory speed sign will be added after a speed survey is made to determine the advisory speed. These changes are expected to occur in May. Further observations will be made to determine the effectiveness of the actions.

Old Business

a) Update on Spring paving contract. Is it approved? Can we get the contractors schedule when available. Contract is approved and bid opening will be on April 20. Construction schedule will be available.

b) Status of providing painted crossing lane at the intersection of Thompson and Chestnut. Pedestrian counts were made. The count was less than required to warrant crosswalks. No action will be taken.

c) Request for more Bicycle lane signage on Orchard Road. Public Works indicates that some Share the Road signs may be missing and they will try to find them.
