Old Business:

- a) Status proposed parking control at Black Lake Canyon Drive and Via Concha

Public Works is waiting for a response from the BL Home Owners Association.

New Business:

- a) Speeding on Mesa between Tefft and Osage

Julie Smillie, a Mesa resident presented a comprehensive list of the Mesa problems and proposed solutions. Public Works had considered most of the solutions but, will seek to find funding for a permanent driver feedback velocity assembly and will be adding additional signing and striping as needed.

- b) Stoplight timing at Tefft and Pomeroy.

Timing has been changed.

- c) Results of speed survey on Mesa between Easy Lane and Viva.

There have been no new speed surveys. The next survey will be in FY20/21

- d) Dawn Road between Albert Way and SR-1 appears to be a public right-of-way. Why is it gated and why are there No Trespassing signs on it.

Property was offered for dedication by the owners but, not accepted by the County.

- e) Eucalyptus debris on El Campo between Woodland Hills and Halcyon.

Public Works has submitted a work order.

f) Future road maintenance requirements for Camino Caballo from Calle Fresca to Maggie Lane.

This was to inform Public Works of a future impact

g) South Tejas Traffic Circle Pilot Project

Cori Marsalek showed us plans for a demonstration traffic circle at Tejas and Ida. There would be minimal impact from this project.

h) Update on Tefft Interchange Improvements.

Cori Marsalek presented a drawing of proposed improvements to the Tefft Interchange which include ramp widenings and restrictions on left turns from northbound South Frontage.

i) Los Berros Bike Lanes Update.

Cori Marsalek described a project that would construct bike lanes on Los Berros from Avis toward Dale
