Old Business:

1. Where are we with the Tefft Interchange improvements.

No change in status.

2. Update on the parking problem on the Black Lack Canyon Drive approaching Via Concha.

Road width is adequate for the purpose. Parking limitation on the North side will not be allowed. Consideration will be given to a parking limitation on the South side.

3. Could you talk about the next steps and the futuring of the El Campo closure? We know it is a SLOCOG project and is not an active element of the Regional Transportation Plan nor is it part of the South County project list but, it is a County right-of-way even though the Eastern portion is within the Arroyo Grande sphere of influence.

There is no funding available for any improvements at this intersection. CalTrans will make improvements after the Winery's complaint is resolved. Public Works will consider actions at other interchange areas after project is complete.

New Business

- There are concerns expressed by Trilogy residents about the truck route designation for Mesa Road. What is entailed in changing the 'Truck Route' designation.
 Truck route designation will remain. Removal of '*Truck Route*' sign will be considered.
- 2. Though our County Supervisor is not committed either way to the State Parks proposal for the Oso Flaco Lake portion, there is a County right-of-way and road extending from SR 1 to the existing boardwalk at the lake. State Parks will probably be required to improve the intersection at SR 1 and widen Oso Flaco Road. I don't think the RTP or the South County Plan include any funding for those purposes. What involvement will Public Works have with respect to the improvements and review of the Transportation and Circulation element of the EIR.

There is no apparent County funding available for road improvements. Mike will check on the fact that there is no apparent County funding available for road improvements. Public Works will be evaluating the EIR for transportation issues.

3. Additional information from Public Works

County will be considering acceptance of Trilogy roads. Consideration is being given for intersection warning signs on Black Lake Canyon Drive. All way stop signs are being installed at Tefft and Mesa.
